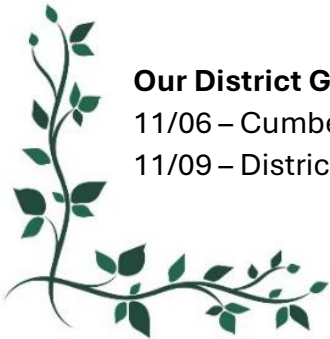

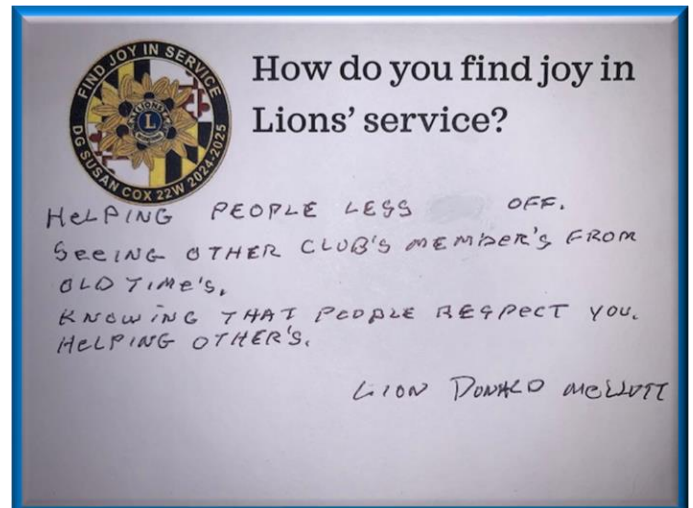

### LIONS CAMP MERRICK-HISTORY

Lions Camp Merrick has a rich camping history. Established in the 1930's by the Merrick Family as a boys camp for the greater Washington D.C. area. In the 1950's it was donated to the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Washington to operate as a camp for Deaf children. In 1983 Camp Glyndon and the American Diabetes Association began providing and overnight experience at Lions Camp Merrick for children with type one diabetes. In 1988 the Lions District 22-C officially made the camp a Lions District project and leased the camp from the Archdiocese to serve Deaf, Blind and visually impaired children and adults. At present LCM continues it's mission to support the Deaf, Blind and Diabetic communities through our programs.



**Developing Special Friendships...**Trust occurs when children feel safe and accepted. At Lions Camp Merrick campers learn, laugh, and live together. Campers form friendships with other children they can connect with, and who are facing the same challenges as themselves. Campers have fun filled days participating in activities that include swimming, fishing, canoeing, challenge course and archery.

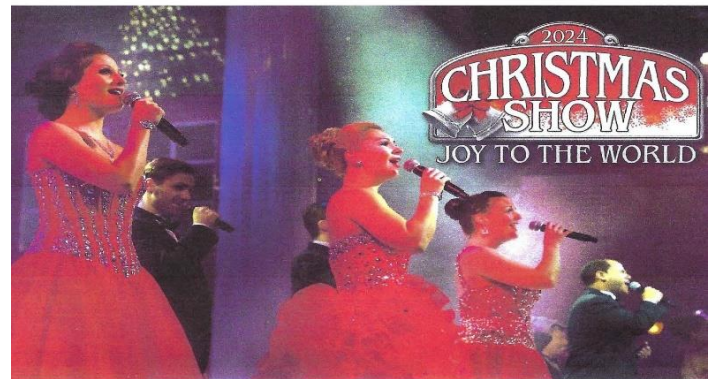
