Flooding Disaster in Western MD Response: After torrential rain and flooding last week across Region I, District Governor Susan immediately went into action and applied for an LCIF Disaster Relief Grant for Allegany and Garrett County. Within hours the \$15K grant was approved. Funds will arrive soon. In the meantime, District 22W Emergency Response Contingency Funds will be used. Lions from across the District gathered information and started to form a communication plan to best respond to those in need. Three local Lions, Region I Chair Robbie Reckart, First Vice District Governor Elect Leon Cardiff, and President Gene Munro began managing and delivering supplies with the help of additional Lions as needs were discovered. This included buckets, cleaning supplies, ice, water, etc. to Westport and Lonaconing. They are working closely with the District Executive Team and President Bridgette Karalewitz from Lonaconing LC. 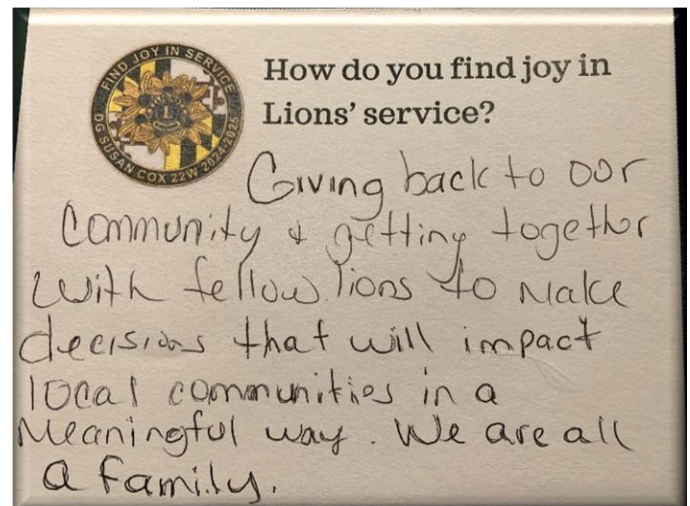
