Second Vice-District Governor was the Administrative Assistant for the Multiple District Council of Governors in 2008- 2009. She has participated in all levels of Leadership training including Emerging Lions Institute, Advanced Lions Leadership Institute, and Faculty Development Institute. To further her leadership training, she attends MD 22 Conventions, Lions International Conventions and USA/Canada Forums. Second-Vice District Governor Nadja's forty-one-year career in nursing began when she graduated from a Licensed Practical Nursing program. She continued her education by completing an Associate Degree in Nursing followed by a Bachelor of Science of Nursing, and finally completed a Master of Science in Nursing degree. During her career, she has worked in the areas of HIV/AIDS, State Penitentiary-Death Row, Schizophrenic Transition Housing, End of Life Care, Neurosurgery, Bariatric, Medical Surgical Nursing and Nursing Management. She currently holds a position as Nurse Care Manager at Chambersburg Hospital, Chambersburg, Pennsylvania.

Lion Nadja is a member of the Lower Marsh Creek Presbyterian Church where she served as a Deacon and member of the Missions Committee. She continues to participate in the choir and remains on the Missions Committee. She plans to retire in January 2022 so she can focus her attention on serving the Lions in District 22-W as District Governor.
