## Will I Be Able to Attend the Forum Virtually?

There are no plans for a hybrid or virtual component to the Forum at this time. However, the Forum's Executive Committee is evaluating options as a contingency plan if border restrictions prevent members from Constitutional Areas 1 and 2 and Multiple District 60 from attending the Forum. A decision regarding contingency plans will not be made by the Executive Committee until Summer (July meeting), to allow more time for progress in pandemic responses and potential adjustments to restrictions.
