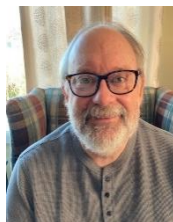

DISTRICT 22W AWARDS

DISTRICT 22W HONOR ROLL

The District 22W Honor Roll Award recognizes Lions who have rendered outstanding service to their clubs and their communities at the “grass roots” level over an extended period of time, who exemplify the spirit of Lionism through their unselfish dedication and who are deserving of District-wide recognition for their efforts in support of Lionism.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Lions who have been members for at least five years are eligible for nomination to the Honor Roll. The current Cabinet Secretary, Cabinet Treasurer and Club Presidents are not eligible and may not be nominated. Past District Governors will become eligible five years after their term as District Governor.

NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Each club may nominate one member per year. In addition, the District Governor may submit two nominations, none of whom may be members of his/her home club. Nominations are to be in writing, signed by the nominee's Club President or Secretary, or the District Governor, and shall list the reasons the nominee is considered deserving of the award by providing a detailed description of the nominee's service and activities in support of Lionism. Nominations may be made at any time during the Lions year but must be submitted to the First Vice District Governor by email or US mail postmarked no later than March 15th.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Award recipients shall be selected from among the nominees by a committee chaired by the First Vice District Governor and consisting of the Second Vice District Governor, Cabinet Secretary, Cabinet Treasurer, and the nominee's Zone Chair. The committee may select up to ten recipients per year. The final selection of the recipients will be based solely on the above eligibility criteria and only what is submitted on the nomination form.

AWARD PRESENTATION

Honor Roll Award recipients will be announced by the First Vice District Governor at the first District business meeting during the Multiple District Convention. The names of all recipients, and their clubs, shall be inscribed on a master plaque which will be updated each year and displayed at the convention. Each recipient will receive a certificate signed by the District Governor.

DISTRICT GOVERNOR'S MEDAL OF COMMENDATION

The District Governor's Medal of Commendation will be awarded by the District Governor to individuals (Lions, LEOs and non-Lions) who have demonstrated performance above and beyond what is normally expected during the operation of the club, a club project or a special event or occurrence.

Nominations for this award will be made, in writing, either by letter or email directly to the District Governor stating the name of the individual nominated for the award and will include the date(s) and location of the event, project or occurrence and a short description of why the individual believes a District Governor's Medal should be awarded. The decision on the issuance of the commendation will rest solely with the District Governor.

Presentation will be made by the District Governor or a Cabinet officer designated by the District Governor at an appropriate meeting or ceremony.

CLUB AWARDS

All club and individual awards run from July 1, 2021, to June 30, 2022. Specified objectives must be met to qualify for the award. Awards will be presented at the Change of Banner and Awards Night.

To receive any of the awards listed below, the Club Secretary must verify and attest to the eligibility for receiving the award and submit this confirmation to the Administrative Assistant, Lion Mark Kyle, no later than July 3, 2022. The Club Secretary and Club Service Coordinator are encouraged to make regular reports to LCI/MyLion on club activities as this will help document awards related requirements.

Club Service Coordinator Award

To qualify, club service coordinators/chairs must complete the following listed criteria.

1. The Club held four “Hands on service projects”. Hands on service projects are performed when the club builds, collects, distributes, or provides something directly to a non-Lion. Cash donations are wonderful but will not count for this requirement
2. Complete a project in three of the five Lions Global Causes: Vision, Hunger, Diabetes, Environment, and Childhood Cancer.
3. Attend the service coordinator training at the District 22W Officers’ Training (or, if serving an additional term, attended a District 22W Officers’ Training within the past two years), or attend a similar training presentation by the District or Multiple District or complete an on-line training course from <https://lionsclubs.org/en> (report completion of on-line training to the GLT Coordinator Lois Conrad and the Administrative Assistant Mark Kyle).
4. Ensure that the club’s service activities are reported to LCI (MyLion) monthly in which the activity occurred for six of the twelve months. No report will be accepted after July 3, 2022.

Club Marketing and Communications Award

To qualify, marketing and communication coordinators/chairs must complete the following listed criteria.

1. Ensure that pictures from at least two service projects are posted on social media. The pictures should include a Lions logo, banner or sign and the posting may include #WeServe or #22WLions.
2. At least two press releases or articles have been submitted to the local media (print, cable, radio, television) about club fundraisers and/or service projects planned or conducted. Copies of submittals may be provided to AA Mark Kyle as confirmation.

Club Membership Director Award

To qualify, club membership directors must complete the following listed criteria.

1. Ensure that the club has a current brochure or information sheet to hand out to prospective members and to Administrative Assistant Mark Kyle.

- a. Ensure that the brochures or information sheets are displayed at the club's service activities and fundraisers.
2. The club held a prospective member event: Friendship Night, recruitment table, letter writing campaign or another prospective member event.
3. Attend the membership chair training at the District 22W Officers' Training or attend a similar training presentation by the District or Multiple District or complete an on-line training course from <https://lionsclubs.org/en>. Report completion of on-line training to the GLT Coordinator Lois Conrad and the Administrative Assistant Mark Kyle.
4. Ensure the orientation of all new members at the club or district level.
5. The club achieves a net gain of **ONE** in membership for the year based on the number of members on the LCI records as of July 1, 2021, and June 30, 2022.

Club Leadership Award

To earn this award, 10% of club members must complete a leadership training course. The following courses, seminars, or events will count toward this award.

1. Club training using LCI-provided training programs.
2. District training sponsored by the GLT.
3. Online training courses from the Lions Learning Center on www.lionsclubs.org/en or as part of the Lions University. Upon completion of this independent study, documentation should be forwarded to the GLT coordinator Lois Conrad and the Administrative Assistant Mark Kyle.
4. Attend the USA/Canada Leadership Forum.
5. Attend the Advanced Lions Leadership Institute.
6. Attend the Multiple District Lions Leadership Institute.
7. Attend seminars provided at the Multiple District Convention.

Club Secretary Award

1. The Club Secretary (or designated substitute) has attended the following Lions meetings during the year:
 - a. The secretary's training at the District 22W Officers' Training. The secretary may complete an independent study presentation/Club Secretary Module found on <https://lionsclubs.org/en>. Upon completion of this independent study, documentation should be forwarded to the GLT Coordinator Lois Conrad and the Administrative Assistant Mark Kyle.

- b. All Zone meetings or Region-wide meetings held during the year in their Zone or Region.
- c. One cabinet meeting.
- 2. Complete Monthly Membership Reports to LCI/MyLCI by midnight of the last day of the month.
- 3. Ensure that the club's Service Activities are reported to LCI monthly in which the activity occurred in six of the twelve months. No report will be accepted after July 10, 2022.
- 4. Annual Club Officers Report on MyLCI/MyLion to LCI must be completed by April 30, 2022.
- 5. All communications from the District and LCI have been forwarded or made available to all club members.
- 6. Minutes of all board meetings are presented to the board for approval and are available to the full membership for review.

Club Treasurer Award

- 1. Attend the treasurer's training at the District 22W Officers' Training. The treasurer may complete the online club treasurer courses in the Lions Learning Center at www.lionsclubs.org/en. Upon completion of this independent study, documentation should be forwarded to the GLT Coordinator Lois Conrad and Administrative Assistant Mark Kyle.
- 2. Prepare a club budget and have it approved by the club Board of Directors and the entire club by August 31, 2021.
- 3. Prepare monthly club financial reports with separate accounting and reporting for Administrative, Activities and Foundation accounts (if applicable).
- 4. Submit IRS Form 990 by November 15, 2021, for the club.
- 5. If the club has a 501(c) 3 Foundation, submit an IRS Form 990 within 5 months of the Foundation's year end.
- 6. Ensure that the club does not have an unpaid balance of \$100 or more to Lions Clubs International as of June 30, 2022.
- 7. Ensure that the club's International dues are paid no later than September 15, 2021, and February 15, 2022.
- 8. Ensure that the club's District dues are paid no later than October 15, 2021 and April 1, 2022.

Club Newsletter Editor Award

To receive this award, the Newsletter Editor will send newsletters to the District personnel listed below. The

Administrative Assistant, Lion Mark Kyle will track the clubs' monthly newsletters for this award.

1. Issue a club newsletter monthly beginning July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022.
2. Email or mail by the US Postal Service a copy of each newsletter to the following district personnel:
 - a. District Governor
 - b. 1st Vice District Governor
 - c. 2nd Vice District Governor
 - d. Cabinet Secretary
 - e. Cabinet Treasurer
 - f. Region Chair (home region only)
 - g. Zone Chair (home zone only)
 - h. Administrative Assistant
 - i. District Marketing and Communications Chair
 - j. District Newsletter Editor

Club President's Award

1. The club has conducted at least one major service activity during the year in at least three of the five Lions Global Causes: Vision, Environment, Hunger, Childhood Cancer and Diabetes.
2. The club conducted a Friendship Night or other prospective member event during the year.
3. The President certified that all new members have been properly indoctrinated, assigned to committees and involved in the work of the club.
4. The Club submitted a report of club activities to the Zone Chair 10 days prior to each cabinet meeting.
5. The President (or designated substitute) has attended the following Lions meetings during the year:
 - a. The president's training at the District 22W Officers' Training. The president may complete the independent study presentation/Club President Module found on <https://lionsclubs.org/en>. Upon completion of this independent study, documentation should be forwarded to the Administrative Assistant, Lion Mark Kyle.
 - b. All four Zone meetings or Region-wide meetings held during the year in their Zone or Region.
 - c. **ONE** cabinet meeting
 - d. One Leader Dog event
 - e. The LCIF Melvin Jones Event
 - f. The LVRF event
6. The Club President has conducted or attended monthly board meetings.
7. The First Vice President has conducted at least one business or board meeting during the year.

8. The club has participated in at least one of the Vice District Governors' Service Challenges.

22W FEED THE HUNGRY PROGRAM

To receive this award, the Club Secretary or the Service Coordinator must report the following activities to LCI/MyLion no later than July 3, 2022. In addition, the Club Secretary must send confirmation of eligibility to the Administrative Assistant, Lion Mark Kyle, no later than July 3, 2022.

1. Collect and donate to a local food bank and/or individual needy families at least 12 food items per member for the year, based on the club's membership as of July 1, 2021.
2. Items may be purchased or collected at fundraising events from the attendees.
3. Clubs may make monetary donations, with \$1.00 equal to one food item.
4. Report the total number of food items or monetary donations throughout the year using MyLion.

22W Reading Action Program 2021-2022

To receive this award, the Club Secretary or the Service Coordinator must report the following activities to LCI/MyLion no later than July 3, 2022. In addition, the Club Secretary must send confirmation of eligibility to the Administrative Assistant, Lion Mark Kyle, no later than July 3, 2022.

The club participates in the District 22W Reading Action program by donating at least \$100 in books in support of a book drive or literacy program, or by participating in a reading program. Books may be given to a library, school, daycare center, Maryland Book Bank, etc.

Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF) Award

Eligibility for this award will be verified by the District LCIF Coordinator, PCC Brian Cox, no later than July 3, 2022.

1. The club appoints a club LCIF chairperson.
2. The club donated to LCIF by either:
 - a. Donations of \$1,000.00 or more (the total of Club and individual member donations.)
 - b. At least 25% of the club members participate in the "Campaign 100/100" by making a minimum donation of \$100.00 to LCIF.

3. At least two club members attend the Melvin Jones Fellowship event.

Lions Vision Research Foundation (LVRF) Award

To receive this award, the club must complete four of the following.

1. The club makes a donation to LVRF and the Low Vision Fellow Endowment Fund. This can include club donations, Vision Days collections, memorials or other related activities.
2. At least one club member participates in LOVRNET as a Patient Interviewer and/or Direct Services Volunteer.
3. At least one club member attends the LVRF Rally event (either in person or virtually) on November 20, 2021.
4. The club holds a Vision Days collection event.

Club Visitation Award

To receive this award, the Visitation Chair or the Club Secretary will send visitation slips to the Zone Chair who will in turn notify the Administrative Assistant, Lion Mark Kyle, no later than July 3, 2022. Visitations may be made in person, by telephone conference call or by any other electronic virtual platforms provided by the club.

1. Visit all clubs in the Club's region that are meeting.
2. Visit at least three Clubs in District 22W outside the club's region.
3. Visit at least one club outside of District 22W.
4. Lions intending on making a visitation **MUST** notify the club secretary of the club being visited at least 5 days prior to the meeting.

A visitation team shall consist of at least two members. The District Governor, 1st & 2nd Vice District Governors and candidates for those offices may not be counted as part of the visitation team unless the visitation is to a club outside of District 22W. The visitation team must stay for the entire meeting and obtain a signed visitation slip from the visited club's Secretary or President.

Visitations may be made at Region/Zone meetings. However, visitation credit may only be awarded by the club hosting the Region or Zone Meeting. In addition, Region Chairs, Zone Chairs, Club Presidents and Club Secretaries (or their designated substitutes) may not be

counted in the visitation team, as they are required to be present at Region/Zone meetings.

Visitations will be awarded for attendance at District Socials, Cabinet meetings, joint meetings, and district events (Leader Dog, LVRF, and Melvin Jones). The visitation team for these specific events must include at least two members of the club. Only the club hosting the event will be able to issue a visitation slip.

The visitation chair or the Club secretary should mail visitation slips to their respective zone chairs. The zone chair will notify the Administrative Assistant, Lion Mark Kyle, of all clubs in his/her zone who are eligible for this award.

Club New Members Award

To receive this award, the Club Secretary or the Club's Membership Chair must provide the names of the new members added during the year to the Administrative Assistant, Lion Mark Kyle no later than July 3, 2022. Transfers in will be counted toward the total of new members added during the year.

1. **Peak** - The club added 10 or more new members during the year.
2. **Pinnacle** – The club added 4 to 9 new members during the year.
3. **Plateau** – The club added 1 to 3 new members during the year.

Club Excellence Award

1. The club has complied with the Association's constitution and by-laws as well as the policies of the International Board of Directors and has refrained from any action encouraging unauthorized use of the name, goodwill, emblem, the marks "Lions", "Lions Club", "Leo", "Lions International" or "Lions Clubs International" and other insignias of this Association.
2. The club's International dues are paid no later than September 15, 2021, and February 15, 2022.
3. The club's District dues are paid no later than October 15, 2021 and March 15, 2022.
4. The club achieved four (4) out of the following eight (8) awards for the year: Club President, Club Secretary, Club Treasurer, Membership Chair, Service Coordinator, Newsletter Editor, Marketing and Communications Chair, and Visitation.

5. The Club had a net gain of at least one new member by June 30, 2022.
6. At least two members of the club attended the following (if held either in person or virtually):
 - a. LCIF/Melvin Jones Event
 - b. District 22W Social
 - c. MD 22 Convention
 - d. Change of Banner and Awards Night
7. The club must have participated in at least one of the Vice District Governors' Service Challenges.
8. The club achieved any seven (7) of the following between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022:
 - a. The club contributed to the Lions Saving Kids Sight Foundation
 - b. The club contributed to District 22W Diabetes Awareness
 - c. The club contributed to District 22W with funds designated for either Camp Merrick maintenance and operations and/or diabetic camperships.
 - d. The club contributed to the District 22W Mobile Screening van.
 - e. The club contributed to the Lions Quest Program.
 - f. The club contributed to the Lions Youth Foundation (LYF)
 - g. The club contributed to Leader Dog.
 - h. The club contributed to LVRF.
 - i. The club sponsored an entry in the Peace Poster Contest.
 - j. The club sponsored an entry in the American Heritage, Preservation and Patriotism Essay Contest.
 - k. The club participated in the District 22W "Roar Like A Lion" event
 - l. The club assisted an individual in their community with a hearing aid, held a hearing screening in their community, collected used hearing aids for recycling as reported in MyLCI/My Lion between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022 or contributed funds for deaf camperships.
 - k. The club sponsored a Lions club, a branch club, or a specialty club.

LEO AWARDS

To receive this award, the Club Advisor will send confirmation of eligibility to the District LEO Chair no later than June 15, 2022.

LEO Club Excellence Award

Lions Clubs International offers more than 20 award programs to acknowledge Leos and Lions active in the

Leo Club Program for their accomplishments. Please note that only Leo and Lion officers reported to Lions Clubs International are eligible to receive awards and certificates. Contact the Leo Club Program staff for more information.

District 22W may nominate one Leo Club for this award per fiscal year. The nomination must be made by the District Governor and endorsed by the District Leo Chairperson. An application form (LEO105) will be made available to the District Governor. This form is to be completed by the District Governor and endorsed by the District Leo Club Chairperson. It should be submitted along with a detailed written report of the nominated Leo club. Leo clubs considered for this award shall be judged for excellence in the following categories:

- Serving others
- Developing and executing creative fundraisers
- Exercising effective leadership
- Enhancing the public image of Leo clubs
- Completing administrative operations

A detailed written report along with the completed application form must be received by the Lions Clubs International office no later than August 15, 2022.

100% Leo Club President Award

This award should be presented at the end of the fiscal year to the Leo club president if he/she has met the following criteria:

1. The Leo club shall comply with the Standard Leo Club Constitution and Bylaws and the policies of the International Board of Directors and shall refrain from any action encouraging unauthorized use of the name, goodwill, emblem, and other insignias of the association.
2. The Leo club shall show a net increase in active membership for the fiscal year. Or, the Leo club president must have personally sponsored one or more new members into the Leo club prior to the end of the fiscal year.
3. The Leo club president must ensure that all members are reported to Lions Clubs International through MyLCI.
4. The Leo club must have conducted at least one major service activity and report the service project through MyLion. This may be a joint community service project with the sponsoring Lions club.

5. The Leo club must have conducted at least one major fundraising project with substantial membership participation.
6. The Leo club must have conducted one joint community project with the sponsoring Lions club.
7. The Leo club must have reported projects and activities through MyLion.
8. New club officers must have been reported to the Young Lions and Leos Department on the Annual Membership Report Form or via MyLCI prior to July 1.
9. The Leo club president must certify that all new members have had proper orientation and are assigned to a working activity or service committee.
10. The Leo club president must have been recommended by the Leo club advisor to the sponsoring Lions club president, who shall certify that the Leo club president has met all the requirements thereof.

Certificates are sent to sponsoring Lions club presidents in April. This certificate may be awarded by the Leo club advisor with the approval of the sponsoring Lions club president.

Leo of the Year Award

The award shall be available to any current Leo club member who is in good standing, meets membership age requirements as provided in the Standard Leo Club Constitution and By-Laws and is not a previous recipient of the award. Consideration shall be given to a Leo club member who has:

- Demonstrated outstanding leadership skills by holding Leo officer positions. Please ensure leadership positions are reported in MyLCI.
- Achieved a superior record as a Leo in implementing successful service projects.
- Made an identifiable contribution to the development and growth of the Leo Club Program by recruitment of 4 Leo members.
- Achieved distinction in community or school activities outside of Leo club commitments.

The nomination must be submitted on the official application form (LEOLOY) for the award. After a Leo is chosen from the district, the nomination is sent to the Multiple District Council of Governors who may nominate no more than one Leo from an officially certified Leo club in good standing sponsored by a Lions club within the Multiple District. The application must be signed by the Multiple District Council Chairperson in office during the fiscal year in which the nomination is made.

This application must be received at Lions Club International headquarters, (Young Lions and Leos Department, 300 W. 22nd Street, Oak Brook, IL 60523-8842 USA) by March 1 of the fiscal year for which the candidate is nominated. Award recipients shall be named by the International Board of Directors at their final meeting of the fiscal year. The award shall be sent to the Council Chairperson or District Governor, as appropriate, for presentation.

Leo Club Advisors' Outstanding Service Award

The award should be presented at the end of the fiscal year by the Leo club president to the Leo club advisor.

The Leo club must have:

- Complied with the Standard Leo Club Constitution and the policies of Lions Clubs International.
- Refrained from any action encouraging unauthorized use of the name, goodwill, emblem or insignias of the association.

In addition, the Leo club advisor must have:

- Prepared and implemented an on-going leadership development program for members of the Leo club, and guided Leo club officers in fulfilling their leadership functions.
- Motivated Leo club members to be service-minded and promote fellowship.
- Regularly attended Leo club meetings, fostered a healthy rapport and communication between the Leos and the sponsoring Lions club, and kept Lions club members informed on the status and progress of the Leo club through regular reports.
- Actively assisted the Leo club in conducting major service and fundraising projects.
- Demonstrated the ability to listen to young people, identify their needs and interests, and give constructive advice and encouragement.
- Promoted the Leo club's participation in district activities or in activities with other Leo clubs.

Please note: the certificate will be emailed to the email address provided on the nomination form. You will be able to print this certificate off on any printer for presentation. Please submit the completed form to leo@lionsclubs.org.

Five Tips for Serving Safely in Your Community

Lions Clubs International - March 31, 2020

The ongoing coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic may be changing the way we live, but it has not changed who we are. We are Lions and We Serve. But during this global health crisis, it is important to keep yourself and your family safe and healthy. And Lions around the world have found new and creative ways to do both. Your club may have already developed a safe strategy to lead a community response to COVID-19, but if you're still looking for new ways to serve, consider these five tips for serving safely that Lions clubs around the world have put into action.

Keep in touch - Social distancing does not mean social isolation. Catch up with family, friends, neighbors and fellow Lions by phone or email and see how they are doing. There are also many people in your community, such as the elderly, who may not have as many opportunities to communicate with family and friends. Consider recruiting your club into a phone tree to reach out and have a conversation with someone who would enjoy talking to a caring, friendly person.

Get social - Social media has become such an essential part of how we communicate because it is so effective. Spread hope by sharing stories about how your club is helping your community during this crisis. By posting information, updates, and safety tips, you can start a conversation online and transform your club's social media network into a communications hub for your community.

Fight hunger - It is important to make sure that we do our part to meet the needs of our community. And fighting food insecurity is a great way to provide comfort to those in need without having to leave your home. Your club can support your local food bank or homeless shelter through fundraising or even by ordering a care package of other essentials like toilet paper, toothpaste, and clothing. When you make sure that your neighbors have what they need at home, you help them to limit their exposure and ensure that we can all get through this together.

Give the gift of safety - As you serve during this crisis, your personal safety is the most important thing to remember. And due to a shortage of cleaning supplies and personal protective equipment, such as masks and gloves, this is becoming even more challenging. While

many Lions have come together to form mask-making groups and have generously shared their cleaning supplies, it is essential that you make sure to take care of yourself. Remember to serve safely. You too are a part of the community you are serving.

Find a partner in service - Your community is full of experienced professionals and organizations that are also doing their part. And many of them need help. Whether it is supporting hotlines or providing translation services, you and your club have the skills they need to strengthen your community's response to COVID-19 — without having to leave home. The relationships you form can help you continue to improve the future of your communities. In a time when people are depending on you more than ever, we are depending on you to take every precaution to serve safely. That is the only way we can get through this together.

Let us know how you are serving safely. Post your stories on social media using the hashtag #WeServe and inspire other Lions around the world to do what they can to help their communities. Because we are all in this together!

CLUB SAFETY OFFICER

Every club should have a safety officer whose job it is to improve the safety of each Club event. The Safety Officer should inspect the event site to identify and correct possible safety concerns. Although not a complete list, here are some common things the safety officer should be looking out for:

- Adequate lighting inside and outside of the event site.
- Overloaded electrical circuits
- Loose or misaligned equipment
- Equipment not properly maintained
- Dull blades
- Trip hazards
- Loose or non-existent traction pads on steps or ramps
- Overhead hazards
- Supplies or equipment stacked too high
- Presence of first aid kit and fire extinguisher
- Improperly marked exit signs
- Presence and use of personal protective equipment (goggles, hearing protection, fluorescent traffic vests, etc.)

No matter how good the safety inspection, things happen. When something happens that injures a Lion, a guest, or a private citizen, provide immediate first aid and assistance. If there is any doubt at all, call 9-1-1. The experts can decide if the victim needs to be transported. Any incident where additional medical treatment is likely should be reported to the District Governor and to LCI. LCI carries insurance that should be in effect for any Lions' sponsored event.

Provide evidence of automatic insurance coverage from Lions International for your events. Lions can produce their own Certificate of Insurance through the following:

PROTOCOL

Official Protocol

Protocol is an official expression of good manners. The courtesy we show each other in our everyday lives affects our attitudes, our work and, in turn, how we view ourselves as human beings. Protocol means respect for position. It is a form of etiquette. Protocol is nothing more than exhibiting GOOD MANNERS to an invited guest of your District or Club.

Order of Precedence

The following is the official protocol policy of the International Association of Lions Clubs. Only the principal speaker is required to acknowledge all dignitaries present. Lions shall be recognized in the following order:

General Comments

When a Lion holds more than one title, he or she shall be recognized for the highest one. In areas that have positions in addition to those previously listed, they should be recognized in accordance with local customs, provided that elected officers always have precedence over appointed ones.

It is recommended that Melvin Jones Fellows be recognized as a group. In introducing speakers, their status as Fellows should be mentioned.

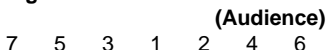
Non-Lion Dignitaries

Non-Lion dignitaries should be given precedence in accordance with local protocol and/or custom, keeping in mind that if the non-Lion is the principal speaker, then he or she should be seated to the right of the chairman.

Head Table Seating

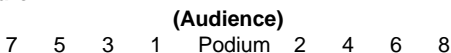
The presiding officer or meeting chair must always be seated at the most central seat at the table when there is no central podium, shown as seat number one in the following diagram (Figure 1). The principal speaker should occupy seat number two, then other Lion dignitaries in accordance with the general order of precedence. If possible, there should be the same number of seats to the right and left of the chair or presiding officer (who would normally be the Club President, District Governor, Council Chair, or International President).

As shown in Figure 2, seating at the head table with a podium is essentially the same, except the meeting chair or presiding officer is always seated at the left of the podium (facing the audience) and the principal speaker at the right.

When spouses are present, they should be seated to the member's left when on the left side of the table, and to the member's right when seated on the right side of the table.

Multi-Head Tables

If there is more than one head table, the table at the highest level shall be considered the primary one. Care should be taken not to sit Lions of the same rank at different tables.

Head Table Introductions

Introduction of the head table should begin with the meeting chairman or presiding officer and then continue from the person with the lowest rank on the order of precedence to the person with the highest. When spouses are present at the head table, they should be

introduced with the member (e.g., “Past International Director John Doe and his wife Jane”).

EMAIL ETIQUETTE FOR LIONS

1. Do not use the “reply all” feature unless the response is applicable to everyone who was copied on the original message.
2. Be professional. Use the email addresses of Lions for Lions’ business only. (No jokes, stories, political or religious messages.)
3. Include your name and club name in your response. There are hundreds of Lions in our district and everyone does not always recognize your email address.
4. Respond in a timely fashion; usually within 24-48 hours. If you need more time to formulate a complete response, send a reply indicating this so that the sender knows you have received the message and are working on the issue.
5. If you or your club have had problems with phishing scams, please go to the link below. Learn how to protect yourself, your Lions club, and the Association from phishing on this website:

6. Never reply to a suspicious email requesting money. Report such email to your internet provider.

OFFICIAL VISIT OF DISTRICT GOVERNOR

Your District Governor is required by Lions Clubs International to make at least one official visit to every club within the District. In most cases the District Governor is the highest-ranking officer of Lions Clubs International to visit the Club during the year. During the Official Visit certain procedures or protocol should be followed:

1. Do not schedule other programs during this visit.
2. Publicize your Governor's visit.
3. Have your attendance committee strive to secure excellent attendance at this meeting.
4. Encourage all members to wear their Lions' Club name badges.
5. Have your District Governor properly introduced to each Lion. Usually, the President or Master of Ceremonies should do this. The Cabinet Secretary, or other District Officer, will provide the official introduction of the District Governor during the meeting.
6. When the Governor is introduced, the Club members should stand, and in like-manner, should also stand at the conclusion of the talk.
7. A brief Board of Directors meeting should be scheduled following the regular meeting. This is the appropriate time for members to ask questions and participate in a discussion with the Governor. Accordingly, full attendance by the Board is appreciated, as well as attendance by all other interested members of the Club. To permit the Governor to be able to respond and offer the best possible advice, it would be appreciated if special problems or questions are made known to the Governor well in advance of the visit.
8. Your District Governor welcomes suggestions for improvements in the District.

Regular Member is our “standard” membership for community members interested in volunteering, serving the community, and making our world a better place. Regular members pay an entrance fee (US\$35) and full international dues (US\$43). Additional district, multiple-district and club dues apply.

Family Member provides families with the opportunity to receive a special dues discount when they join a Lions club together. The first family member (head of household) pays full international dues (US\$43), and up to four additional family members pay only half the international dues (US\$21.50). All family members pay the one-time entrance fee (US\$35). The Family Membership Program is open to family members who are (1) eligible for Lions membership, (2) currently in or joining the same club, and (3) living in the same household and related by birth, marriage or other legal relationship.

Student Membership allows students to make new friends and help others in their community at the same time. Students enrolled in an educational institution who are between the age of legal majority and through age 30 pay no entrance or charter fee and half international dues (US\$21.50). Students over age 30 who are joining a Campus Lions club pay a US\$10 entrance fee and full international dues.

Leo Lion Membership allows current or former Leos between the age of legal majority and through age 30, who have been a Leo for at least a year and a day, to continue doing volunteer work with LCI as a Lion. Leo Lions pay no entrance fee or charter fee and pay half international dues (US\$21.50). To encourage Leo Lions to invite their friends, young adults between the age of legal majority and through age 30 who join a Leo Lions club receive the same fee waivers and dues discounts as Leo to Lion members.

Former Leo Members over the age of 30 who have been a Leo for at least a year and a day pay no entrance fee or charter fee when joining a Lions club.

Entrance Fees

There is a single entrance fee of \$35 for new members including charter members.

HISTORY

Multiple District 22

The 16th District of Lions Clubs International was organized in 1921 and consisted of the states of New Jersey, New York, Maryland, Delaware, and the District of Columbia. Because of rapid growth it became necessary in 1922 to divide the area – New Jersey remained as the 16th District, New York became District 20, and Maryland, Delaware and D.C. became District 22.

The Baltimore club was the first to organize (October 26, 1921) within the boundaries of the present District 22. In 1940, District 22 was divided into Districts 22A and 22B. In 1944, District 22C was organized, followed by Districts 22D and 22W in 1947. The Frederick club was the first to have organized (June 7, 1922) within the boundaries of the present Sub-District 22W.

Multiple District 22 is divided into the following sub-districts:

- District 22A – Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Harford and Howard Counties and Baltimore City
- District 22B – Caroline, Cecil, Dorchester, Kent, Queen Anne's, Somerset, Talbot, Wicomico, and Worcester Counties
- District 22C – Calvert, Charles, Montgomery, Prince George's, St. Mary's Counties, and the District of Columbia
- District 22D – State of Delaware
- District 22W – Allegany, Carroll, Frederick, Garrett, and Washington Counties

A Board meeting should be held at least once a month. All members are welcome to attend but only board members in good standing are permitted to vote on matters brought before the Board.

CLUB CHARTER NIGHT*

*Lions Clubs International designates a club's charter night as the date the charter was recorded at LCI, not the date your charter night was first held. When a club is formed, the club celebrates its first charter night. After about one year of service, the club celebrates its second charter night, and so on. For example, if your club was chartered in 1990, it will celebrate its second charter night in 1991, third charter night in 1992, fourth charter night in 1993, etc. Your club's officially recognized charter date is in MyLCI on the District Clubs' page for each club.

Charter Night is a special event celebrating the beginning of a new Lions club as well as an annual celebration or "birthday" for the club.

The first task is to appoint a Charter Night chairperson and Charter Night committee. The next task is to select a Charter Night date. For new clubs, this takes place approximately 90 days after the charter approval date. For existing clubs, this takes place at a date during the month in which the charter was originally approved.

The next task is the preparation and mailing of Charter Night invitations. The chairperson and his/her committee should confirm attendance, secure entertainment, invite and provide accommodations (if necessary) for the guest speaker, ensure the room is set properly and check that equipment is in working order. It is customary to invite the Lions clubs in your district and those within a reasonable distance. It is also customary to invite the members of the sponsoring club as well as the current district governor, the district governor's spouse or companion and all past district governors within the district.

Another task is to design and print a suitable program for the event. Contents of the program typically include: Cover with club name, Charter Night date, event location and the Lions logo (available at www.lionsclubs.org); name of sponsoring club, list of the charter club officers, directors and members; program agenda; list of people the club wishes to thank; list of club contributions.

CHARTER NIGHT CHECKLIST

Executive Committee

- Appoint a charter night chairperson, preferably the immediate past club president
- Choose a Charter Night date
- Divide responsibilities among committees
- Review and approve plans

Finance Committee

- Determine the budget
- Set the cost of admission
- Approve expenses

Invitations/Entertainment Committee

- Design and distribute invitations at least 30 days prior to event.
- Invite prominent community officials and confirm their attendance (Note: If you invite local officials, the club is expected to cover the cost of their attendance. Clubs should be prepared to allow each to present prepared remarks.)
- Invite guest speakers
- Arrange travel and accommodations (if necessary)
- Confirm attendance of members from clubs within the district and the local area Book entertainment and/or keynote speaker
- Ensure the sound system and equipment is in working order
- Check that the room is set-up properly

Program Committee

- Set the agenda to include the meeting being called to order by the current club president
 - The agenda should include an invocation, Pledge of Allegiance, patriotic song, and Lions or Leo toasts
 - Follow the protocol for seating at the head table and the introduction of guests
- Design and print the program
- Distribute programs to attendees
- Include awards and recognition to be made to deserving Lions (such as membership awards, Melvin Jones Fellowship, etc.)

Public Relations

- Send news releases to the local media
- Contact the media and invite them to the event
- Arrange for a photographer

Charter Presentation Committee (for new clubs)

- Confirm the district governor has received the charter
- Plan and practice the charter presentation

Charter Re-Certification Ceremony (for existing clubs)

- Arrange for the existing charter to be taken to the location of the charter night program
- Display the charter in a suitable place of honor at the program
